# ITINERARY ZAMBIA & ZIMBABWE

## **DAYS 1 & 2: MCHENJA, Luangwa National Park**

Arriving at Lusaka you will be met by representative of Roberts Safaris and assisted through the airport to your scheduled flight to Mchenja.

The journey from the airport to camp starts off among the local villages before entering the National Park itself. From the entrance of the Park you will hug the Western bank of the Luangwa River for an hour or more heading north towards Mchenja Camp. This trip takes you through some of the best game-viewing territory in Southern Africa and you will be amazed by what the South Luangwa has to offer even before arriving at camp. Mchenja is one of the Luangwa's best appointed camps. The tents are custom designed, each has a roll top bath and stunning views of the river, there is also a small pool which offers some relief in the warmer months. Game-viewing throughout the Luangwa is excellent and very varied, you will have ample opportunity to explore the area both on foot and in open 4x4 vehicles.

## **DAYS 3 & 4: CHINZOMBO, Luangwa National Park**

Your home for the next two days is the wildly luxurious Chinzombo Camp. 6 Villas all similar in style with an open plan structure in a beautiful position on a sweeping bend of the Luangwa River. It is located 1 hour from the Mfuwe Airport by road and then private access by boat to the camp. Its contemporary design is something new for Zambia but surely is now the benchmark by which all other camps will be measured. Relax and be spoiled! Take in all that Africa has to offer.

## **DAYS 5 - 7: CHONGWE SUITES, Lower Zambezi**

When you leave South Luangwa, you will fly via Lusaka to the Lower Zambezi. Chongwe River Camp is set on the banks of the Zambezi River close to the western edge of the National Park and just 10 minutes away from Royal Airstrip where you will land. It is a tented camp offering the full range of activities available in this wonderfully diverse Park, you will be able to see stunning game on foot, from vehicles or from the water in boats or canoes.

There are two suites at Chongwe each one with its own plunge pool. The Albida suite with 2 rooms ideal for families or friends and the Cassia Suite with just 1 room is perfect for honeymooners.

Chongwe's impressive variety of safari activities provides the ultimate exploration of this magnificent paradise. By land enjoy game drives, walking safaris or take to the river and explore with canoeing, boat cruising or perhaps a spot of fishing. Back in camp the "Hide" is brilliant for photography, especially the shy nocturnal visitor's of the area. The habit also lends itself to African Hunting Dogs or wild dogs who are frequently seen by foot, vehicle or water!

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## **DAYS 8 & 9: VICTORIA FALLS HOTEL, Victoria Falls**

The Victoria Falls are a "must" on any itinerary in this area, whether by foot, boat, canoe, raft, helicopter, microlyte - the options are simply limitless! Known locally as Mosi Oa Tunya or 'The Smoke that Thunders', the Falls drop 111mts into the gorge below.

Victoria Falls has earned itself a reputation as the adrenalin capital of Southern Africa there are numerous exciting activities from bungee jumping to gorge swings and arguably the best commercial white-water rafting in the world. Livingstone Island sits in the middle of the river at the top of the Falls themselves offering unparalleled views to the few guests that are able to venture there.

Echoing its glorious pedigree since 1904, The Victoria Falls Hotel features 161 rooms and suites - truly a five-star experience of pure grandeur. Style, glamour and sophistication are hallmarks of the Executive Suites, which are luxuriously appointed with warm inviting décor. The Victoria Falls Hotel is renowned for impeccable service, luxurious accommodation and exceptional facilities, including complimentary wi-fi for all guests. The 42 Deluxe Rooms of the exclusive, stand-alone Stables Signature Wing are ideal for small family or groups seeking personalised services. ## **DAYS 10 - 12: PAMUSHANA, Malilangwe**

Perched high on a sandstone ridge, Singita Pamushana Lodge's eight elegant suites – all with private plunge pools – is set within the 130,000-acre Malilangwe Wildlife Reserve in Zimbabwe's remote southeast. Drawing inspiration from the rich tribal history of the region, the lodge's design features bold geometric patterns, tile inlays and carved furniture, as well as comforting natural fabrics, raw silks and woven leather elements.

The organic-shaped buildings feature detailed thatch- and stonework, carefully curated interiors, and picturesque views of the landscape and Malilangwe Dam below, while the lodge's expansive decks deepen connections with nature. A cliff-top firepit and signature Singita 'bar-deli' invite al fresco dining and storytelling under the stars.

The spacious suites include four 1-bedroom suites, one 2-bedroom family suite (perfect for two adults and two children), one 3-bedroom family suite (perfect for two adults and four children) and two 2-bedroom suites (ideal for four adults travelling together). The Malilangwe Reserve boasts one of the highest concentrations of the endangered black rhino and its abundant wildlife makes for unparalleled game-viewing opportunities. With private access to this untouched wilderness, guests can immerse themselves in nature on twice-daily game drives, bush walks, sundowner boat cruises, excursions to rock art sites and more.

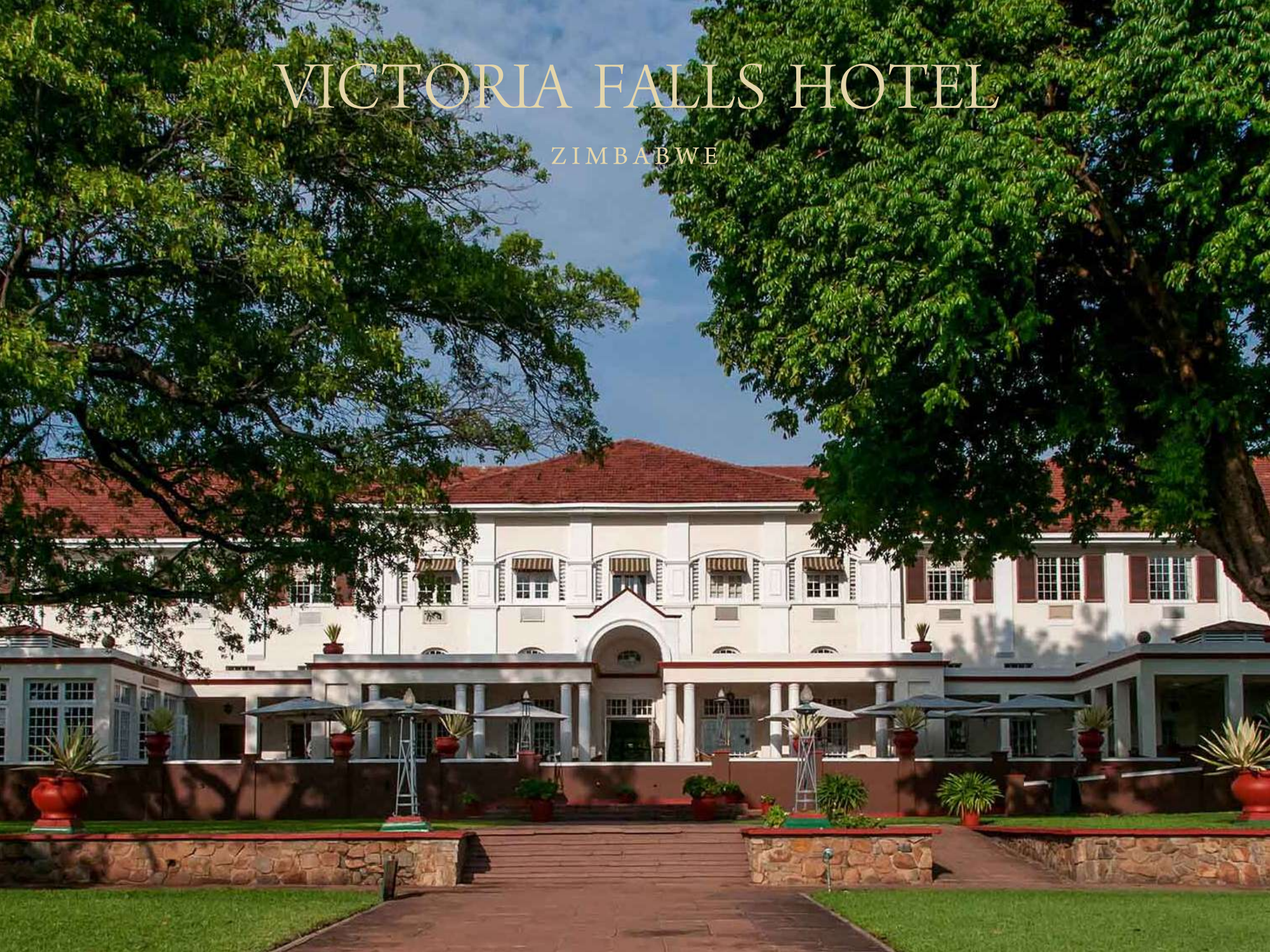

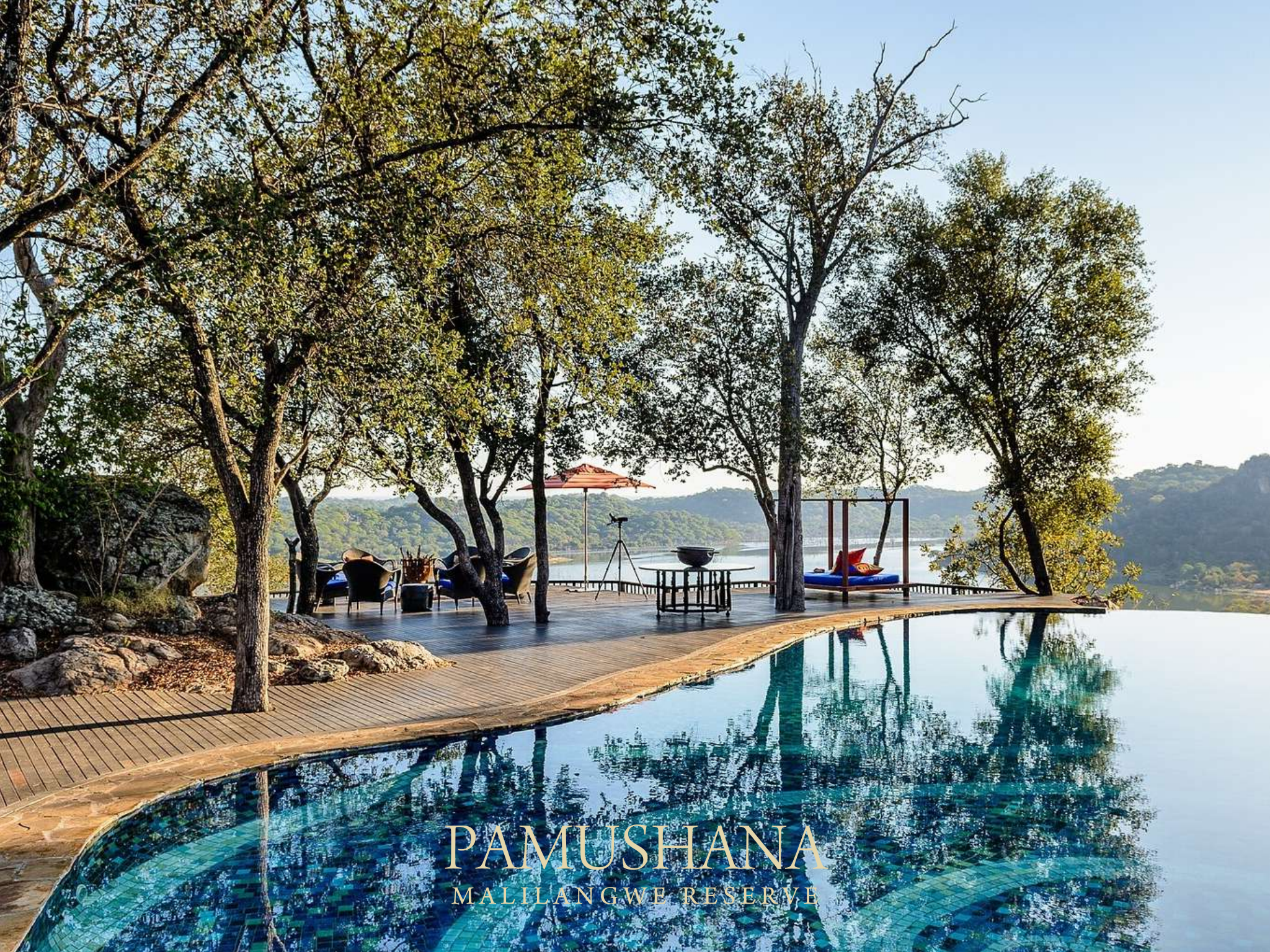
